We are gathering items for the silent auction; Jeri has items, Andrea donated shavings. We still need sponsors and donations for the auction and exhibitors bags. Also, would like to do class drawings for a prize.

A congratulations goes out to Meredith for being appointed as a director for APHA. Brandi gave an update on CCC and that the Goldmine Burbank show had been included as CCC approved.
