



NCPHC Minutes March 29, 2018

The meeting was called to order at 8:08

Minutes:

All members had received the minutes from the last meeting in February. A motion was made by Donna to approve the minutes. Heather seconded the motion. All members present were in favor. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report:

No Treasurer's report. There have been no changes to the account. We currently have over \$11,000.00 in the bank.

Old Business:

2018 Show

President Biggs received an email from Diane Alves regarding the gate person position. Diane Lang has volunteered to be the gate person for the show. She is only requesting a room for herself and her son. Her son will help as ring steward and scribe as needed. The positions of announcer, ring steward, secretary, and the judges for the show have been secured. All contracts have been signed and returned. Buck Brown will be the stall and show manager. Kristi is working with Diane from SJPHC on the class list.

Teri Ray suggested that the club consider an award for the halter classes in honor of Carol Brown. Carol Brown was a longtime supporter of the halter classes. She will be greatly missed by everyone in the horse world. This will be presented to the SJPHC for their review and input.

President Biggs received a spreadsheet from Diane Alves, SJPHC, with items that need to be completed for the show. President Biggs stated that we still need to secure the host hotel. This needs to be done in the next day or so. Brandi said it will be on the top of her list to be completed.

The cost of stalls to the club will be \$60.00 with each club paying half of the cost. Diane (SJPHC) suggested that the stall fees should be \$150 to \$160. President Biggs asked if any members had input on the subject. Renee suggested that we consider a lower rate as this is a new show location that we are trying to get established and we need to make it appealing for people to join us. Renee suggested that we consider \$110 to \$115. Kristi agreed with Renee that we need to encourage people to come to our show. She suggested a rate of \$125. President Biggs will go back to SJPHC with the rate of \$125.

RV fees will be \$35.00 a night.

President Biggs asked Kristi if she has spoken to Steve (SJPHC) about the award for the upcoming show. Kristi has not spoken to him yet but will get in touch with him.

It has been suggested that the classic and master classes be removed. This would mean that there would be no age break out in the Amateur class. It was suggested that we combine the classes to promote more people in each class. The show highpoint awards will be based on the breakdown of each division from the combined classes.

Diane (SJPHC) has spoken to a Farnum representative about being at the show. Farnum is willing to attend and bring awards if the club is willing to use the Farnum name in the show billing. It would be Farnum Summer Spectacular Color & All Breed Show presented by NCPHC/SJPHC. Everyone in attendance felt this would be good for the club and allow more awards for the competitors.

President Biggs spoke to Rita's about having their food truck at the show. They were happy to do it. President Biggs will check with the Corning show grounds to make sure that it was okay for them to be there.

After much discussion about what the club would like to offer to encourage youth members to participate in our show the club came to this agreement.

A motion was made by Teri to have the following price package structure. Gwen seconded the motion. All members present were in favor. Motion carried.

Regular Register: \$300 plus fees, show fees, stalls, and trail cost if participating in trail.
Solid Paint: \$175 plus fees, show fees, stalls, and trail cost if participating in trail.
All Breed: \$150 plus fees, show fees, stalls, and trail cost if participating in trail.
Youth APHA: \$150 plus fees, show fees, stalls, and trail cost if participating in trail.
Youth All Breed: \$150 plus fees, show fees, stalls, and trail cost if participating in trail.
Youth 5-10: classes are free, cost are fees, show fees, stalls, and trail cost if participating in trail.

President Biggs will present the package pricing to Diane Alves (SJPHC). The suggested cost for trail would be \$20 to \$25. Leadline classes will be free.

SJPHC will be holding their next meeting on April 10th. Our next club meeting will be April 17th. This should allow the SJPHC to review the items that we had for them and come back to our club with their input before our next meeting.

A motion was made by Brandi to adjourn the meeting. Gwen seconded the motion. All members present were in favor. Motion carried.
